Before Making a Scalp Micropigmentation Appointment

The SMP treatment is an elective treatment, it's a hair density simulation technique designed to recreate a person's desired hairline and/or to make the hair appear thicker and fuller.

During this treatment customized pigments are applied just below the skin in the epidermis, using a sterile micro tattoo needle(s). The SMP treatment is semi-permanent and with proper care can last 4-8 years but is not guaranteed. Clients may experience some discomfort during the SMP treatment as in getting a tattoo. You should be aware that there are potential risks and short-term and long-term side effects of SMP treatment such as (but not limited to) an allergic reaction, scarring, discoloration, the body rejecting the ink, traveling ink, and infection. Although, very rare the adherence to aftercare instructions is imperative but does not eliminate the possibility of these potential risks.

Clients with a history of skin cancer, sun damaged skin, diabetes, heart conditions and/or any other relevant medical condition should consult with their medical doctor before undergoing the SMP treatment. In these circumstances, we may require a signed certificate from your doctor before proceeding with the treatment.

BEFORE TREATMENT

60 DAYS

NO hair-growth-stimulating products on area to be treated.

30 DAYS

DON'T use skincare products containing Retin-A, Retinol (Vitamin A), Alpha Hydroxy Acids (AHAs), Glycolic Acid (AHA), Lactic Acid.

DON'T do any Exfoliating Treatments such as Dermabrasion, Derma-planing, Derma-rolling, Chemical peels, Micro-dermabrasion.

DON'T get Botox injections for three weeks before your treatment.

DO bring written release for your specific procedure from physician if you take products for treatment of Glaucoma, Insulin and/or blood thinners.

DO check with your physician about taking antibiotics before procedure if you typically take before dental visit

7 DAYS

DON'T take supplements/natural blood thinners (Fish Oil, Vitamin E, Flaxseed, Turmeric).

DO let us know, at the time of scheduling, if you are taking a prescription blood thinner.

DON'T wax, thread, tweeze, tint or do anything to your eyebrows.

2 DAYS

NO alcohol.

NO OTC NSAIDS (Aspirin, Ibuprofen, Aleve). NO Acetaminophen.

DAY OF PROCEDURE

DO get a good night's rest and wear something comfortable.

DO expect to be at your appointment for 2 -4 hours, so bring a book, headphones, or something to help you pass the time.
